



FA Patriot Flags Down A Win At BLM Championships

JESSICA ZOSKEY and FA Patriot's start to the Trilogy Saddles Col. Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Championships, held Oct. 21-24 at the Virginia Horse Center in Lexington, was inauspicious. In their fourth level freestyle, Zoskey rode her test in her shadbelly and found herself eliminated for it.

"I rode my freestyle, which all season I rode as an FEI Young Rider freestyle, which qualified me for the BLMs fourth level freestyle. So I wore my shadbelly when I should have worn my short coat," Zoskey said. "It was a silly mistake. I warmed up, went around the ring and scored a 67 percent on my test. I was the only one in the class, so we would have won."

The next day Zoskey came back in the proper attire, now a shadbelly, and topped the junior/young rider Prix St. Georges on 67.76 percent.

"We've had a very challenging year this year with [Adequan FEI North American Junior and Young Riders Championships] and [Collecting Gaits Farm/USEF Dressage Festival Of Champions], so we really just came here this weekend to have fun," she said. "I just had a really pleasant ride. The highlights were the tempi changes. His extended canter was good, and I think his half-passes were good today."

But while Zoskey, 20, didn't have any wardrobe malfunctions in the Prix St. Georges, FA Patriot did have one. About halfway through their test, "Blue" overreached and pulled off one of his front shoes.

"We rode the rest with only three shoes," Zoskey said. "I felt him grab and pull up, and it felt sort of weird, but he never throws shoes, so I didn't think anything of it. When I came back

through to start my walk, I saw it on the ground. He's very stoic, so he just kept going for me."

Blue is a breed not commonly seen in the dressage ring—he's half Arabian and half Friesian, a cross sometimes seen in the Arabian world.

Zoskey came across Blue (Flurry Of Ca-Lyn—La Sada Mega) about six years ago, when the gelding, bred in Tennessee and then started in Texas, was only a green 6-year-old.

"I grew up riding Arabians and half-Arabians," said Zoskey. "I do love the half-Arabs—I get along really well with them. I was looking for a new horse when my half-Arabian went lame. My mom actually found him in a magazine. Then I kind of went down to see him kicking and screaming because I didn't want a gray horse, and I didn't want a

new horse at all; I wanted my old horse to keep going for me. But as soon as I saw him, I fell in love with him."

Zoskey said she is drawn to the intelligence and work ethic of the half-Arabians. "They enjoy competing, and they enjoy working," she said. "I just like their temperaments and personalities."

Though Zoskey, Chesapeake City, Md., grew up showing several different disciplines on the Arabian circuit, including saddle seat, hunters and side-saddle, her trainer at the time convinced her to give dressage a try. She quickly developed a fondness, especially once paired with Blue. She brought him up to Prix St. Georges with the help of Kathy Rowse and, later, Scott Hassler.

"At a young age, I thought dressage was kind of boring," Zoskey said. "When we started looking for a new horse, my

mom looked for something that could take me further because she saw my talent in dressage was strong. We were looking for something half-Arabian at the time and, not being well-educated in breeds, we thought the Arab-Friesian cross would be great.”

While she said they’ve encountered occasional breed prejudice, most of that has faded through the years as Blue has developed in his appearance and gaits. This year, they placed seventh individually at the NAJYRC (Ky.) and seventh in the young riders section at the Collecting Gaits Farm/USEF Dressage Festival Of Champions (N.J.).

“He is different, and he moves differently, but this season we’ve really developed a better throughness, and his muscling has developed in his topline,” said Zoskey. “I don’t feel like I ran into it as much this season. I rode more accurately and correctly this year; we worked together to develop a more correct form.”

► Sprieser Scores Two FEI Wins

Lauren Sprieser sometimes has to pinch herself when she looks out at her Marshall, Va., operation—Sprieser Sport-horse—and sees all the horses she gets to ride every day. That dreamlike sensation was even stronger after she swept two FEI-level divisions at the BLM Championships.

Victorious, or “Midge,” won the Prix St. Georges, senior section B, on a 66.57 percent, while Ellegría, “Ella,” took home first in the Intermediaire II on 66.31 percent. Midge also topped two open Prix St. Georges classes at the Virginia Dressage Association Fall show, held in conjunction with the championships.

“I look at the two of them in the barn, and their stalls are right next to each other, and I have to kind of slap myself,” Sprieser said. “They’re not only incredible quality horses, but they’re so generous. It’s hard not to get greedy sitting on that caliber of horses every day.”

But Sprieser’s weekend with Ella, a 9-year-old Westphalian (Ehrentanz I—Patrizia, Philipo) mare didn’t start out in such a fairytale way. In her warm-up Intermediaire II class the day before the

finals, Sprieser had to withdraw from the test just a few movements in.

“She just shut down in the bridle, and I had to excuse myself,” Sprieser said. “When she gets insecure she just shuts down in the back and the bridle. I

put her in the snaffle [for the Intermediaire II], and she was unbelievable. It was inspiring, because I know the basic training is good if you can do the entire Grand Prix-level test in a snaffle and have it go well. But at the same time, I need to figure out how to do it in the double.

“My mom says you’re only as happy as your unhappiest child,” she continued. “Not that Ella is unhappy; she’s just very insecure, and she’s an over-achiever. If she thinks she’s failing at something, she thinks it’s the end of the universe. I don’t push horses any harder than they want to be pushed,

but at the same time it’s hard work.”

Sprieser, 26, and Ella competed in the Brentina Cup tests all summer, qualifying for the Collecting Gaits Farm/USEF Young Adult Brentina Cup Championship in August. But weeks before that show, Ella got sick. She came back to work slowly over the last few months, and this was her first show back.

“It is a scary arena,” Sprieser said of the coliseum where the Intermediaire II final was held. “For her to come back and do that in the snaffle not all that long after coming back to work—she really has tremendous heart.”

Midge, an 8-year-old carriage-bred Dutch Warmblood (Patijn—Koriene, Farao) owned by Sprieser’s mother Judith, is another horse with that kind of heart—he’s been exceeding expectations since he arrived at their farm five years ago.

“He is the horse someone is going to make a *Lifetime* movie about one day,” Lauren joked. “He’s the horse no one liked. His breeder passed away, and my mom bought him, and I said, ‘Why?’ ‘Because he’s cute,’ she said. So I thought, ‘He’ll be a resale project, but he’s got a year, and he’ll be out.’ In a year, he’d made a believer out of me, and a year later he made the people I train with believe in him. He is a Dutch Warmblood, and he has Dutch papers, but his ancestors move like Park horses. There is no reason at all for him to be able to do the things he does.”

Lauren has another star waiting in the wings. Her 4-year-old U.S.-bred Oldenburg (Sir Donnerhall—Alabama, Silvermoon) Stratocaster topped a training level class and a first level class at the VADA Dressage and finished fourth in his training level, senior section B, final.

► Picasso’s Bleu Earns Blue

Lisa Lewis-Greene was a little anxious about competing Picasso’s Bleu in the indoor coliseum at the Virginia Horse Center. But her fears were quickly assuaged when “Pablo” took everything in stride and earned a 66.05 percent and first place in the large Prix St. Georges, senior section A, finals. The pair also

finished fifth in the Intermediaire I finals with a 64.47 percent.

“He can be a little nervous, but he was great in that atmosphere. He tried very hard,” Lewis-Greene said. “He’s very focused, a real workhorse—he just loves to work. My trot work came out really strong. I thought I lost him a little in the canter, but he put in a pretty good test.”

Lewis-Greene bought Pablo, a Dutch Warmblood (D-Day—Garina) gelding, three years ago as a 10-year-old from Hilltop Farm and started training with Chris Hickey at the same time. They encountered a serious setback only six months later when Pablo sustained a collateral ligament injury. He had six months of stall rest and then was slowly brought back to work.

TIDBITS

- For Jennifer Foulon, Potomac, Md., and Ferrero, their win in the junior/young rider third level (64.74%) class at the Trilogy Saddles Col. Bengt Ljunquist Memorial Championships was a long time coming. The two have been a pair since Ferrero, a Hanoverian (Federweisser—Sade) gelding, was 4 and Foulon was 9. Foulon, now 16, rides with Barbara Strawson.

She said that while Ferrero was a little spooky in the indoor coliseum he stayed with her to put in a lovely test. “He gets very excited and very nervous, but he’s a very good boy,” Foulon said. “All his lateral work and trot and canter half-passes were really nice.”

- Ashley Zatloukal, 19, and Der Radetzky Moonbeam, a 10-year-old Oldenburg (Der Radetzky—Misbang) mare, topped the junior/young rider second level final with a 67.67 percent.

“This is my first time at BLMs,” Zatloukal said. “We had a little problem with our walk—she got excited and started jiggling—but she was really good other than that.”

- Riding Tony Woodcock’s Hanoverian gelding (Longchamp—Garantie) Livingston, Stacey Hastings topped the second level, senior section B, class with a 67.90 percent and the first level, senior section B, with a 73.85 percent. Woodcock found the chestnut on the Internet about four years ago and paired him with Hastings, Mooresville, N.C., in 2008. The two have scored as high as 80.00 percent at first level.

“He’s just an amazing horse, and we have high hopes for the future,” Hastings said. “I’m thinking he’s close to 18 hands, and he feels like it, but he’s so willing. He’s pretty straightforward. What you see is what you get. I haven’t had much trouble with him; he just gets better and better.”

“Luckily for him it was degenerative fibers, and it wasn’t a tear,” Lewis-Greene, 43, said. “It just needed some time and some little shoeing changes. We did a ton of bodywork and ground-work with him, and he came out of it really well. He came right back into work and into competitions.”

Lewis-Greene, Shamong, N.J., and Pablo showed at fourth level last year, winning the 2009 BLM Championships, and then moved up to the small tour earlier this year. Her husband, Douglas Greene, also competes when he isn’t working in the Air Force and finished third in the third level, senior section A, finals on Madeline. Lewis-Greene hopes Pablo will be her first Grand Prix horse—a dream she’s had since she stopped eventing at the upper levels a few years ago.

“I think my heart was always in the dressage even when I was eventing, but at the time I had horses that really loved



to jump, and that's what they wanted to do," she said. "The older I got, the more my clients were doing the dressage. When I got married it was my husband who said, 'It's time. If you want to do the dressage, let's go out and find a nice horse.' I found Pablo and Chris at the same time, and I haven't looked back."

While Pablo doesn't jump, Lewis-Greene said he often has the feel of one of the Thoroughbreds she used to event.

"He has a good go button to him," she said. "He's tall, leggy, a little bigger than I like to ride, and my husband and Chris told me he was smaller than he was before we went to see him. They knew I wouldn't buy him if I knew how big he was. He has a very grounded head but rides a lot like a Thoroughbred. I've never been on a horse that gets so focused and really loves to work. He just loves the challenge and comes out every day with a smile on his face, like, 'What are we doing today?'"
